Membership Regulations in the Eurasian Movement for the Right to Health in Prisons

1. General Provisions

1. 1. These Regulations are developed based on the Bylaws of the Organization and are approved by the Board.
1. 2. Members of the Organization can be individuals and legal entities.
1. 3. Individuals belong to the Organization as individual members.
1. 4. Legal entities belong to the Organization as organizational members and exercise their rights and obligations through a representative delegated by them.
1. 5. If an individual member becomes a representative of an organizational member, their individual membership shall automatically terminate.
1. 6. The Organization may replace its representative at any time by notifying the Secretariat in an official letter sent to the Organization's email address.
1. 7. Each member of the Organization (individual or organizational) has one vote at the General Meeting.
1. 8. Members of the Organization must share the vision, mission, and values of the Organization.

2. Membership Procedure

2. 1. Individuals and legal entities wishing to become members of the Organization fill out a membership form on the Organization's website, which is a written application for membership.
2. 2. Applications for membership from legal entities must include the contact details of the representative who will exercise the rights and obligations of a member of the Organization.
2. 3. The received forms are processed by the Secretariat. If any necessary information is missing, a Secretariat employee will contact the candidates to obtain it.
2. 4. Candidate applications are sent to Board members, who vote for or against the candidate's admission to membership via email or at a

Board meeting. The decision to accept or reject membership applications is made by a simple majority of votes.

2. 5. An employee of the Secretariat informs the candidate of the Board's decision by email.

3. Membership Rights

Members of the Organization have the right:

3. 1. Elect and be elected to the Board of the Organization. Only individual members of the Organization may be members of the Board. Organizational members have the right to elect members of the Board through their delegated representative, but their delegated representatives may not be elected to the Board.
3. 2. Receive letters of support for participation in conferences and when submitting grant proposals.
3. 3. Participate in events organized by the Organization and its partners.
3. 4. Take part in the Organization's advocacy initiatives.
3. 5. Receive technical support from the Organization on implementing the right to health in prisons.
3. 6. Speaking publicly on behalf of the Organization.
3. 7. Make proposals regarding the activities of the Organization.
3. 8. Contact the management bodies of the Organization to protect your legitimate rights and interests.
3. 9. Apply to the Board with a request to convene an extraordinary General Assembly or a Board meeting.
3. 10. Voluntarily leave the Organization by submitting an application to the Board of the Organization.

4. Membership Responsibilities

4. 1. Take part in the General Assembly.
4. 2. Share the vision, mission, and values of the Organization.
4. 3. Contribute to the development of the Organization's capacity.
4. 4. Form a positive image of the Organization.
